Exam Instructions:

- Your exam has two parts
 - Multiple Choice part: This has to be answered on the Computer sheet using **pencil only**. (You will receive a computer sheet along with your exam). Any response written using pen will not be graded.
 - Problems: These will have to be answered in the exam booklet (**only in INK**), in the space provided. If the provided space is not adequate for you, you may use the back of the exam to complete your answer. However anything written on the back of the exam should be properly and clearly labelled. Anything not clearly labelled will not be graded.

Breakup of the Final Exam:

The exam consists of:

28 Multiple Choice Questions → Worth 70% (@ 2.5 points each question)
4 Problems → Worth 30%

Multiple Choice Questions:

17 Concept Questions → worth 42.5%
11 short problems → worth 27.5%

Problems:

- Mostly numerical problems, one short answer question
- Understanding of concept required for explaining the results (example: negative NPV → reject the project)

Chapters 1,2 & 10 – Introduction and Market Efficiency	→ 11%
Chapter 5 – Time value mechanics	→ 12.5%
Chapter 6 & 7 – Bond and Equity valuations	→ 27.5%
Chapters 8 & 9 – Portfolio Theory and CAPM	→ 12.5%
Chapter 12 – Options	→ 10.5%
Chapters 13, 14, 20 and 3.5 – Capital budgeting and cost of capital	→ 26.0%
